Ensuring Academic Breadth:

- It is important to us that all students maintain a strong academic element to their curriculum. There are two main reasons for this:
 - studying a broad and balanced curriculum;
 - access to qualifying subjects Post 16.
- Students are therefore required to choose **at least one** subject from the Academic Breadth group.
- Students predicted to achieve strong passes in a range of qualifying subjects should **seriously** consider taking French and a humanities subject alongside the core of English, maths and science. In some schools this is the only 'choice' offered to some students.

- At the top of the Options Planning Form there is a space for you to write the latest progress check data for the Academic Breadth subjects.
- Considering this data before choosing which options you wish to study is important.
 - If a student is likely to find an academic, examination heavy curriculum a struggle then choosing three Academic Breadth options may not be a wise move.
 - Equally, where a student's predicted GCSE grades suggest that they are likely to achieve strong grades across a range of Academic Breadth subjects then choosing more than one may be appropriate.

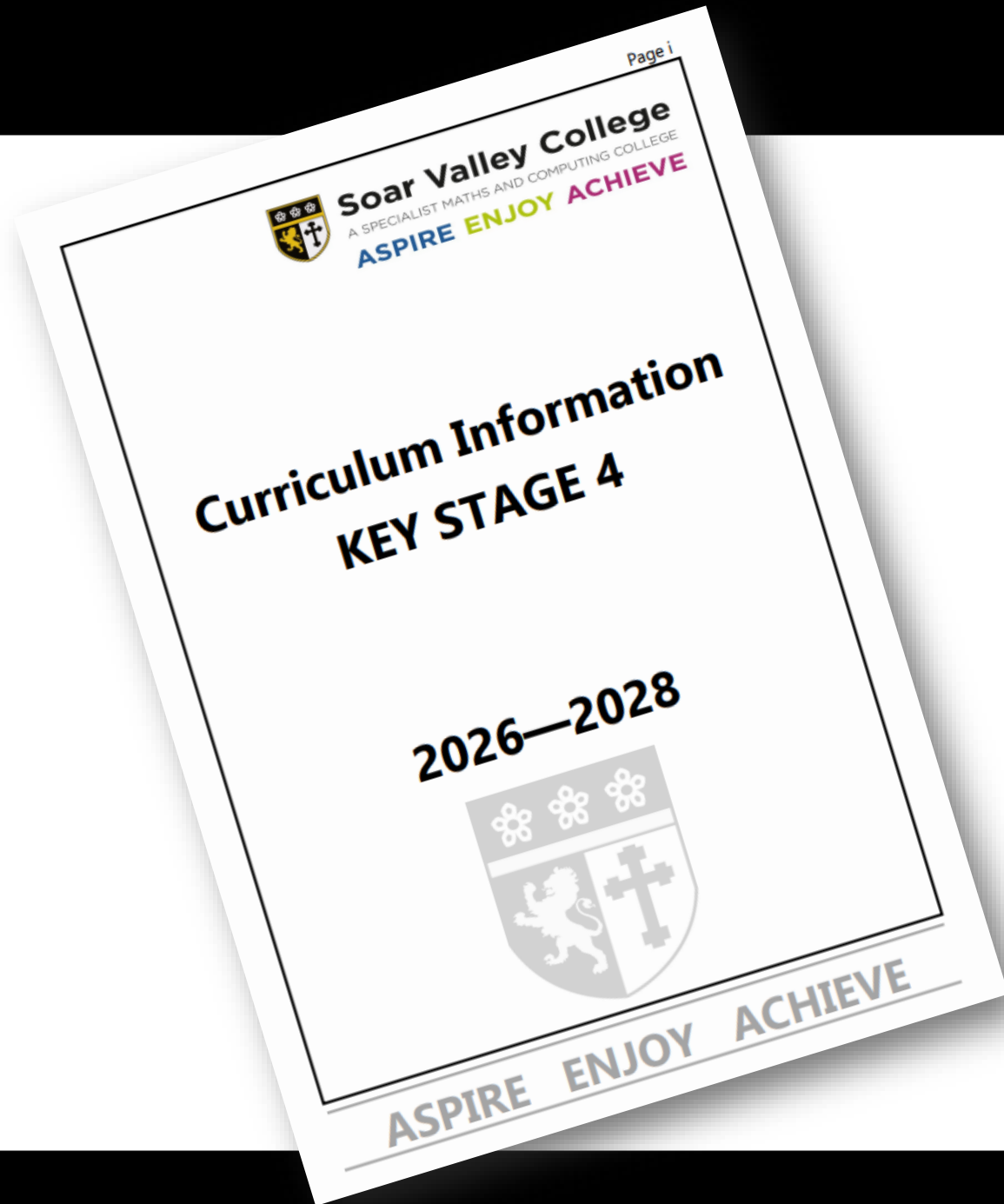

Making the Right Choices:

- **OPPORTUNITIES:** Options booklet, teachers, careers information, research...
- **DISCUSS:** What are the student's opinions? What are parents' opinions? What questions do you have?
- **FACTS:** Make sure choices are based on facts, not *assumptions*.
- **SUBJECT:** Base the decision on the work, not friends or teachers.
- **JUSTIFY:** Make sure there are good reasons for every choice.

- What will be studied? *Will I really enjoy all/some/none of it?*
- How will the subject be assessed? *Is there a lot of coursework content? Will the workload be manageable?*
- What sort of qualities or skills are needed? *Am I likely to be successful with the qualities/skills I have?*
- What college courses will be available for further study? *Where will it lead?*
- What careers might be available? *Do I need to pick this subject if that's an area I want to pursue in the future?*
