

# **Year 10 Transition Evening**



### Top tips for parents:

- 1. Get your child to talk to you about what they have learnt in school. You do not have to be a subject expert, but students discussing their learning with you is a great way to reinforce the days learning.
- 2. Stick a copy of the key dates on the fridge, that way you can help them to plan ahead.
- 3. Please provide them a distraction free environment. Switch off all mobile phones, televisions, etc.
- 4. Check their planners or the Show My Homework website for work set.
- 5. Make sure your child is aiming for 100% attendance between now and their final exams.
- 6. Make sure they are getting enough sleep, enough water and a healthy diet. A well-fed and rested brain learns significantly better, and will make a huge difference to your child's ability to concentrate and learn.
- 7. Do Praise/reward effort when good work is produced both in and out of school.
- 8. Try to help your child to manage their time and to start revising early. This gives space and time for your child to have some well-earned rest and avoid unnecessary stress.
- 9. Encourage your child to use the online resources such as Sam learning, GCSEpod, my maths etc.
- 10. Make sure that your child knows the correct exam boards, and has any required texts and revision guides.

#### Sam Learning:

All students have log in details for SAM learning, ask them to show you the facility. The **centre ID** is **LE4SV**.

#### Why use it?

- Research shows that students using SAM Learning for just 10 hours a term can gain on average **two GCSE grades better** than those that do not use it across their best 8 subjects.
- Creates greater independence.
- Supports your child in consolidating key areas.

#### **Show My Homework:**

• This is a wonderful tool for both students and parents to track, complete and plan homework. We recommend that parents/carers check to ensure that students are on top of their work.
